RE: FY 2021 State General Fund Allotments

In a memorandum dated June 25, 2020 (attached), Larry Campbell, Director of the Budget, has advised that the expected resources of the State General Fund are likely to be insufficient to cover appropriations made against it and that the use of an allotment plan as provided for in KSA 75-3722 et seq. is necessary and beneficial to the state. In accordance with the authority granted by this statute, an allotment system is now imposed upon selected State General Fund accounts for FY 2021, effective July 1, 2020. Implementation of the allotment system is necessary to ensure that State General Fund expenditures in FY 2021 will not exceed State General Fund resources.

The attached spreadsheet outlines the reductions that are to be applied to affected agencies. If you have questions about this process, please contact your analyst in the Division of the Budget or Larry Campbell, Director of the Budget.

SUBJECT: FY 2021 State General Fund Allotment

After considering current revenue information, the FY 2021 approved budget, and other pertinent information, it appears that the resources of the State General Fund are likely to be insufficient to cover the appropriations made against the State General Fund. Therefore, I advise that the use of an allotment plan as provided for in K.S.A. 75-3722 is necessary and beneficial to the state.

I estimate that the State General Fund is projected to have a FY 2020 ending balance of \$89.2 million, which will carryforward as the beginning balance of FY 2021. The approved FY 2021 State General Fund revenues from all applicable revenue sources are estimated at \$7,230.5 million. When combined with the beginning balance, the resulting total amount available is \$7,319.7 million. For FY 20201 expenditures, the 2020 Legislature approved \$8,024.1 million. The 2020 Legislature adjourned Sine Die without a statutorily and constitutionally balanced State General Fund budget. Considering these factors, I estimate that the FY 2021 State General Fund ending balance will be approximately \$704.4 million below zero unless corrective action is taken through an allotment plan.
